




IS YOUR RODENT MANAGEMENT KILLING COYOTES?

Over 500,000 coyotes are killed in the United States each year. A quiet culprit responsible for many of these deaths is rodenticide (i.e. rat poison). Find out how you can help.

HOW DOES RAT POISON AFFECT COYOTES?

Rodenticides kill more than just rodents – they lead to slow, painful deaths of carnivores like coyotes. How does this happen?

1. Rodents ingest poison from a trap.
2. A coyote eats the poisoned rodents, passing the poison to the coyote.
3. The poison weakens the coyote's immune system, making it vulnerable to disease, malnutrition, dehydration, and secondary infections.

4 TIPS FOR COYOTE-CONSCIOUS RODENT MANAGEMENT

1. **Seal Entry Points:** Close cracks and entry points to your home, including small areas where wires run from the exterior to the interior.
2. **Store Food:** Make sure food sources are stored in rodent-proof cans and trash bins.
3. **Deter Rodents:** Use spearmint, cayenne pepper, or hot sauce to repel rodents.
4. **Use Non-poison Methods:** If other steps fail, use snap traps, CO₂, or RatX as non-poison options for rodent control.
